2024 DDG-5 Reunion

At the Crew Meeting on Saturday of the 2023 Reunion, it was voted to hold the next reunion in 2024 to adjust the year to coincide with the 60th anniversary of the renaming of our ship from USS Biddle to USS Claude V. Ricketts. As a result, this year's reunion will happen on Long Island New York. The host hotel is the <u>East Wind Long Island</u> in Wading River, New York. The Reunion will be held from Sunday, July 28, 2024, to Friday, August 2, 2024. Room rates were negotiated to be \$179 (plus taxes) per night for those nights only. Outside of the reunion dates, hotel room rates are quite a bit more expensive, so if you're planning on arriving earlier or leaving later you may want to investigate rates at other nearby hotels for those nights.

The 2024 registration form and schedule are included at the end of this newsletter. You can also find them on the 2024 Reunion page of the website. To make it easier for you, it's suggested that you fill out the online form since it will do all the math for you. Once filled out, print it and send it to Glenn Johnson at the address at the bottom of the registration form along with your check. You will need at least Adobe PDF reader to do this. The reader can be found here (https://get.adobe.com/reader/) if you don't already have it. Otherwise, you can print the form found at the end of this newsletter, fill it out and send it to Glenn.

The deadline for getting your registration form into Glenn to be eligible for drawings for free tours or free dinners is July 1, 2024. The number of free tour or dinner drawings are dependent on the number of reunion registrations we have so the more the merrier.

FYI, the hotel has one on-site restaurant. However, they open at 1130 and don't provide breakfast. Why? You'll have to ask them. As of right now, breakfast will be provided in the hospitality room consisting of donuts, bagels, coffee, and other items. We will have available a list of nearby restaurants that do provide breakfast should you be interested.

I hope this newsletter finds you and yours all well. We will be celebrating the 60th anniversary of the commissioning of the USS Claude V. Ricketts DDG-5 as well as the NATO Mixed Manning Demonstration (MMD), at the East Wind Long Island hotel, in Wading River, NY, from Sunday, July 28th departing Friday, August 2nd.

The East Wind Long Island is located 60 miles east of Manhattan on 26 lush acres of vineyards with Shoppes within walking distance. The hotel is accessible by three airports: JFK, LaGuardia (NYC), and Islip MacArthur (30 minutes from hotel). We will have a hospitality room open daily. After checking in to the hotel, look for signs pointing to the hospitality room or ask the front desk for information about the DDG-5 Crew Member Association room.

We have some exciting events planned, including a charter bus day trip into NYC, and a tour of the USS Intrepid with lunch in the city. Also, many local east end attractions are only a short drive from the hotel including wineries, a casino, beaches and much more.

The DDG-5 Banquet Dinner and Chinese Auction will happen Thursday afternoon/evening, August 1st from 5pm to 10pm. The banquet will consist of several different stations having a variety of selections to choose from. The banquet menu is attached at the end of this newsletter for your information. Also, if you are planning on attending the reunion, please bring something for the auction.

Additionally, feel free to bring memorabilia from your time on board our ship, such as cruise books, photos, and any other items you might deem interesting.



Shipmate Information Database Update:

I am continuously working on cleaning-up and updating the Crew Registration database and have removed several data entries that weren't consistent or were duplicated across various tables in the database. I am also continuing to keep updated a "good email list" from the registration database table by sending out aperiodic emails to all registered email addresses in the current good email list. If I should receive a "bounced" reply, indicating that the email address is not active, I will place that email address in the bad email list, remove it from the good list, and update the bad email list which can be found on the home page of the website by clicking the red button on the right side of the page. You should check this list every so often to see if you're listed. If you are, contact me ASAP with your updated/changed email address and I'll update the database.

In addition, if you're reading this from the informational posting in the Facebook group about the publication of this newsletter and if you have not yet <u>registered on the website</u>, I would encourage you to do so. It is easy to do and the specific personal information you enter will be kept private except for on board information, which will be displayed in the <u>DDG-5 Crew Roster</u>. If you are already registered and log in to the website, you will be able to email other registered shipmates, via the Crew Roster, as well as being kept up to date on activities for the DDG-5 Crew Members Association.
